DIVISION I: Beginner Equitation. Walk, trot over poles. Open to riders in their first twelve months of showing. Riders may cross-enter into Division II only.

1. Equitation on the Flat (walk and trot)
2. Equitation over Poles (course A)
3. Equitation over Poles (course B)

DIVISION II: Limit Rider Equitation. Walk, trot over Cross-rails 18"

Open to riders of all ages who have not won 2 blue ribbons over fences. Riders may cross-enter into Division I or Division III or IV.

4. Equitation on the Flat (walk and trot)
5. Equitation over Cross-rails 18" (course A)
6. Equitation over Cross-rails 18" (course B)

DIVISION III: Limit Rider Equitation. Walk, trot, and canter over Cross Rails 18"

All ages, open to riders who have not won 2 blue ribbons over fences.

7. Equitation on the flat (walk, trot, canter)
8. Equitation over cross rails 18" (course A)
9. Equitation over cross rails 18" (course B)

DIVISION IV: Hunter 18"

Open to amateur and professional riders of all ages. Fences will include small gate, flower boxes, walls, and poles with outside and diagonal lines.

10. Hunter under saddle
11. Hunter over fences (course A)
12. Hunter over fences (course B)

DIVISION V: Amateur Hunter 2'0"

Open to AMATEURS only (all ages)

Open to Amateurs and Professionals

PLAY DAY CLASSES

PD#1 TRAIL CLASS. Open to all riders. There will be at least 8 challenges including Walk over bridge. Judged on willingness and cooperation with your horse

PD#2 COSTUME CLASS Single horse/rider combination. Judged on originality.

PD#3 BARREL RACE clover leaf pattern; left or right option. Timed event

PD#4 POLE BENDING. Timed event

PD#5 POTATO AND SPOON HACK CLASS. Carry a potato on a spoon at a walk, trot and canter until all potatoes are dropped, last one to drop is winner.

PD#6 RIDE A BUCK bareback, the gate keep will place YOUR dollar under your knee, walk, trot and canter; dollars are collected, the last one to drop their dollar wins all the money.
